Application

T9715 and T9107 thermostatic mixing valves are recommended for all applications where the mixed water temperature needs to be kept exact and constant, and can be changed at will, such as:

- Low-flow sanitary applications: showers, washbasins, etc.
- Electronic valves
- Industrial applications
- Chilled water applications

Installation

Connection: Install shut-off valves close to the mixing valve, at least on the inlets, to enable the device to be isolated for maintenance or cartridge removal, without draining the system. Valves on inlets remain wide open during normal operation.

- Rinse pipes.
- Calibrate: simply move the knob on its notched axis until the temperature scale on the knob and the temperature of the water leaving the mixing valve match.
- Move the knob regularly over the entire scale.



T9715 and T9107 thermostatic mixing valves are specially designed to prevent the contraction of legionellosis:


- Removable, interchangeable cartridge for easy descaling and disinfection.
- Heat treatment: temperature can be raised by simply removing the protective cover and turning the cartridge to the maximum heat position (bacteria are destroyed at 60°C).


